Making pancakes

Hello Everyone! We hope you have had a lovely time during the Easter break.

We had such a wonderful half term in nursery learning about "Dinosaurs/Easter and Growing". Easter is a special time, the time for new life and we have enjoyed looking at the animals and their babies and as always planting and watching our garden grow. We have learnt about healthy foods and have started to grow some for ourselves. During the half term, we had science week where we turned into palaeontologists, studying fossils and ice to find dinosaurs. It was also Red Nose Day where we promoted our British Values by donating money and selling cakes to raise money to help others.

What are we learning this half term?

Our topic this half term is 'Once Upon a Time'. We will be looking at fairy tales and make believe stories. Talking about the different characters in stories and discussing where they lived. Looking at castles and palaces and finding out what these buildings were/are actually used for. We will be learning about the life cycle of a butterfly and will have our own butterfly garden where we will have our own Painted Lady caterpillars that we will look after and watch them change. This is an amazing opportunity for the children to see the full life cycle of a butterfly.

We will listen to lots of fabulous stories throughout the topic.

In maths, we will focus on recognising numerals 0-5 and will be focusing on matching digits to amounts up to five. We will practice counting actions such as fairy jumps, dragon claps and giant steps. When we count, we will try to mark down the amount on a white board or clipboard using numbers, marks or symbols.

In RE we are focusing on "Good News" and "Friends" where the children will discover how everyone has good news to tell and that good news makes us happy. They will learn that Pentecost celebrates the good news of Jesus. We will talk about how to be a good friend.

A nursery lending library can be found in the cloakroom, you can choose one book with your child to take home and share together as many times as you like, all we ask is that you return the book before you choose another one. We send home song sheets/nursery rhymes with the weekly Makaton signs on the back, please practice the signs with your children and have fun singing the songs together.

Also included in each child's book bag is your child's name card and a white board pen so they can practice overwriting, copying or writing their own names at home as well as in nursery.
