5. Finally, light your candle with an adult.

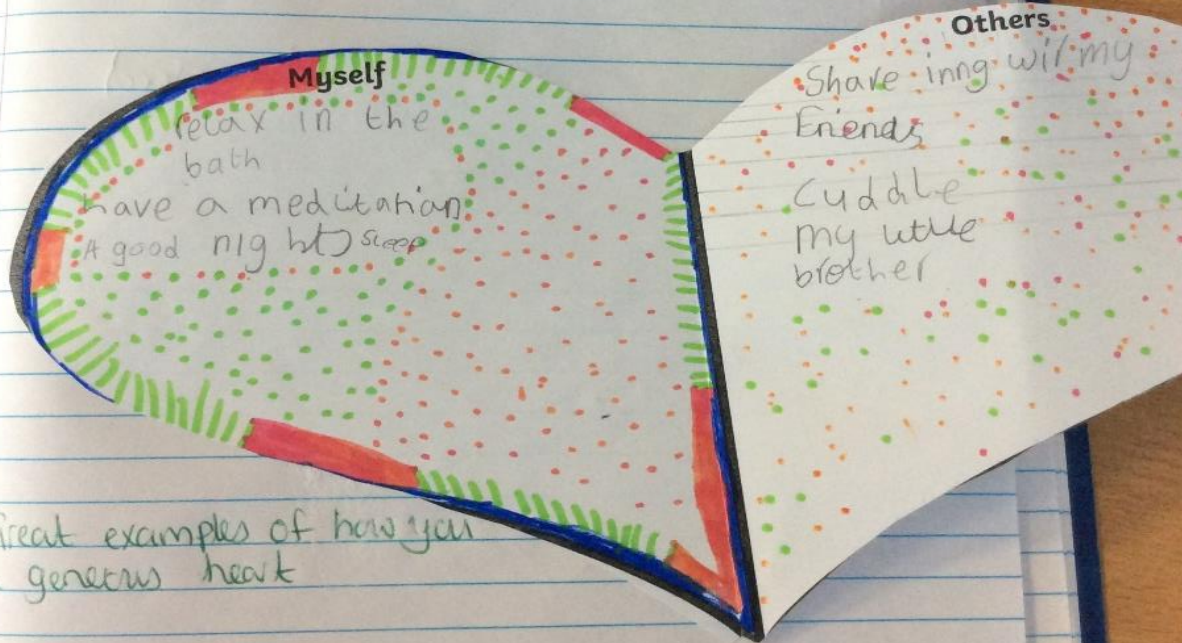
What does the Christingle mean?

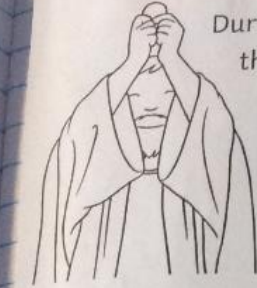

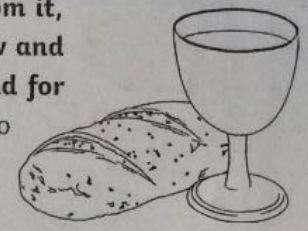

We then remember the Last Supper. At the Last Supper, Jesus said, 'Take this, all of you, and eat of it, for this is my Body, which will be given up for you.'

Afterwards He said, 'Take this, all of you, and drink from it, for this is the chalice of my Blood, the Blood of the new and eternal covenant, which will be poured out for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins.' Jesus told His friends to 'Do this in memory of me.' This is why we come together at Mass, to do what Jesus asked us to, in memory of Him.
